The Town of East Greenwich is requesting that the above referenced project be added to the Transportation Improvement Program FY 2017-2025. Main Street is located in East Greenwich between Division Street and First Avenue. Main Street has historically been a commercial area of the town. It is comprised of mixed uses from residential to commercial. It has a wide array of retail businesses and in recent years it has experienced an increase of restaurants.

Main St. has not received any substantial maintenance in many years. As such, the roadway is in need of resurfacing and the sidewalks are also in need of rehabilitation in many areas. Additionally, the handicap sidewalk ramps need to be brought-up to ADA standards.

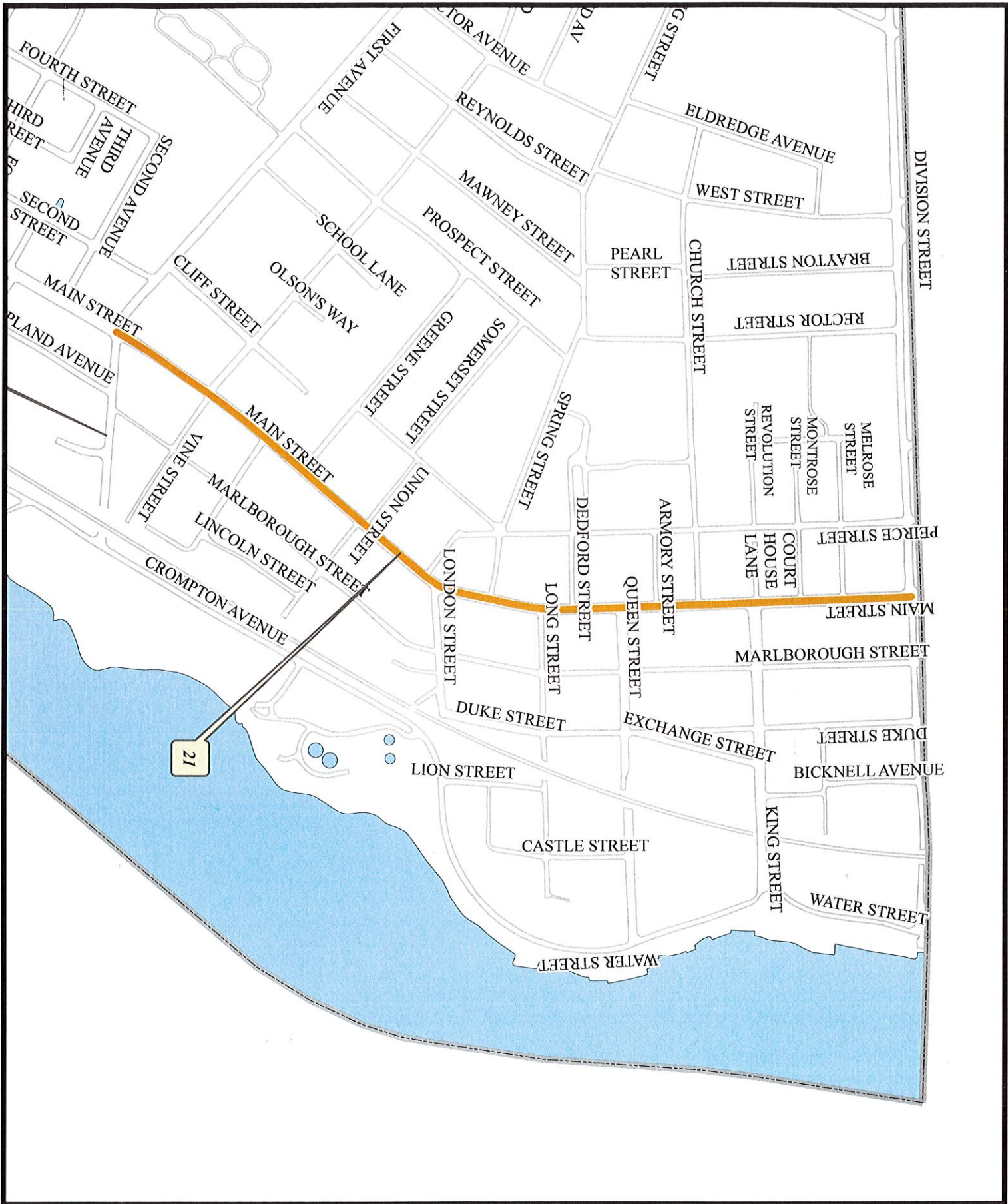
