

The Rhode Island Statewide Planning Program, a division of the Department of Administration, is the central planning agency for state government. The work of the Program is guided by the State Planning Council, comprised of state, local and federal representatives. The objectives of the Program are to plan for the physical, economic, and social development of the state; to coordinate the activities of governmental agencies and private individuals and groups within this framework of plans and programs and to provide planning assistance to the Governor, the General Assembly, and the agencies of state government.

This technical paper is one of a series prepared by the staff of the Statewide Planning Program. These papers present information developed through selected phases of work of the Statewide Planning Program to the program committees and staff, the participating state, local, and federal agencies, and to others interested.

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PREFACE

This report presents population projections for the state of Rhode Island and its 39 cities and towns from 1970 to 2040 by five year intervals. State projections are shown by five year age, sex and color groups, while city and town forecasts are presented by totals only. Annual levels to 1979 are also included.

Standard cohort-component procedures were used to project state totals and city and town projections resulted from trends obtained from cohort-ratio methods. Initial adjustments had to be made to account for annual city and town estimates based on federal income tax returns, along with distributions of new residential building permit data, in addition to consideration given to local area expectations of anticipated population levels. Estimates of the effects of navy base closings particularly the out-migration of military dependents in the communities involved are also reflected in the projections.

State forecasts resulted from a gradual convergence of 1970 state five-year birth rates by age of mother into series "E" levels, currently being used nationally as the most probable expected rate. This rate represents 2.1 births per woman. One half of the most recent net migration experienced in the state was held constant throughout the forecast period. City and town projections were adjusted to add to state totals used as controls for each interval. Programming of five-year age, sex and color distributions of city and town forecasts is currently underway and will be published upon completion, together with a more detailed description of assumptions and methodology used for both state, city and town forecasts.



METHODOLOGY

The number of births to an age-group during an iterative period is found by first calculating the population in an age-group present at the mid-period, using the formula:

and then summing the births over the six age-groups,

SUMMARY

SUMMARY

Analysis of the population projections resulting from the particular constraints of birth, death and net migration assumptions used in this report as input into the projection model, show gradual reductions in state population growth, with forecasted percentage increases remaining below those made for national totals. City and town forecasts generally show a tapering in both growth and loss in relation to previous long-range trends.

Much of the initial increase in the state forecasts were absorbed by the outmigration of navy base personnel and dependents. Forecasted state median age levels reveal consistent increases during each projected period, while a comparison of the proportion of the age group 65 years of age and over to the total population also shows significant increases from current ratios. Projected non-white totals show greater proportional increases than those of white totals during this same time.

Most of the drop in the rate of population growth for most of the lower age groups however, is not reflected until after 1990 when the reduction in the number of women in the child bearing ages finally takes place as a result of the projected lowered birth rates. Up until that time, the increase in the child bearing population resulting from previously large numbers of births occurring before 1970 compensates to some extent the results of low birth rates forecasted along with actually creating some moderate increases in the proportion of the 15 to 44 age group during the initial forecast periods. A comparison however, of most of the selected age groups presented in the tables, below age 65 from 1990 shows reductions in each of the proportions of the total population throughout the remaining forecast period.
