ABSTRACT: This paper presents 2000 Census data about the travel Characteristics of workers in Rhode Island by city and town. Seven tables are included: Employed – By Place of Work, Employed – By Place of Residence, Commuting to Work – Mode of Transportation, Mean Travel Time to Work, Vehicle Availability, Population by Specified Age Groups, and Commuting Patters – Rhode Island Workers by Place of Residence and Place of Work.

RHODE ISLAND 2000**

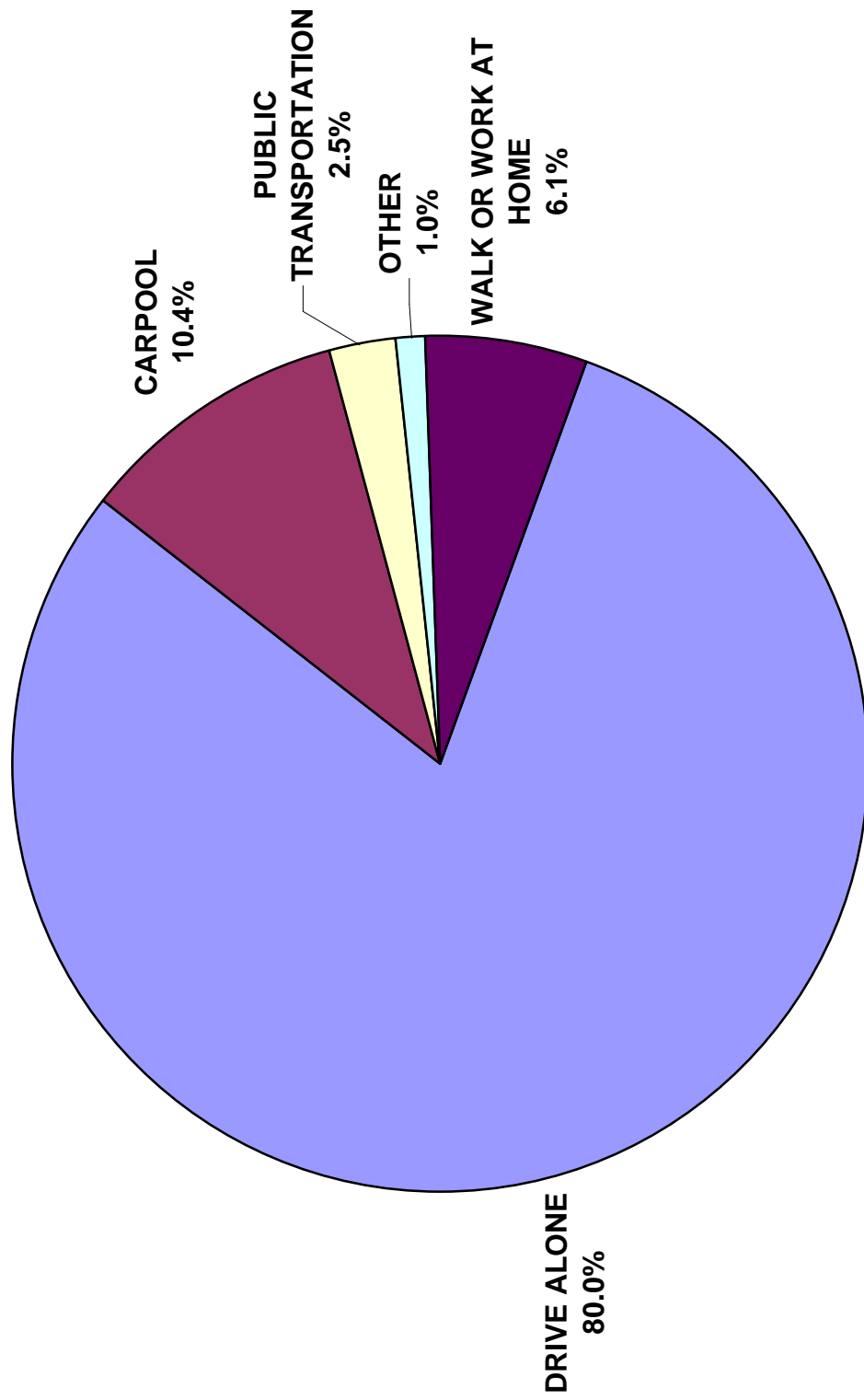

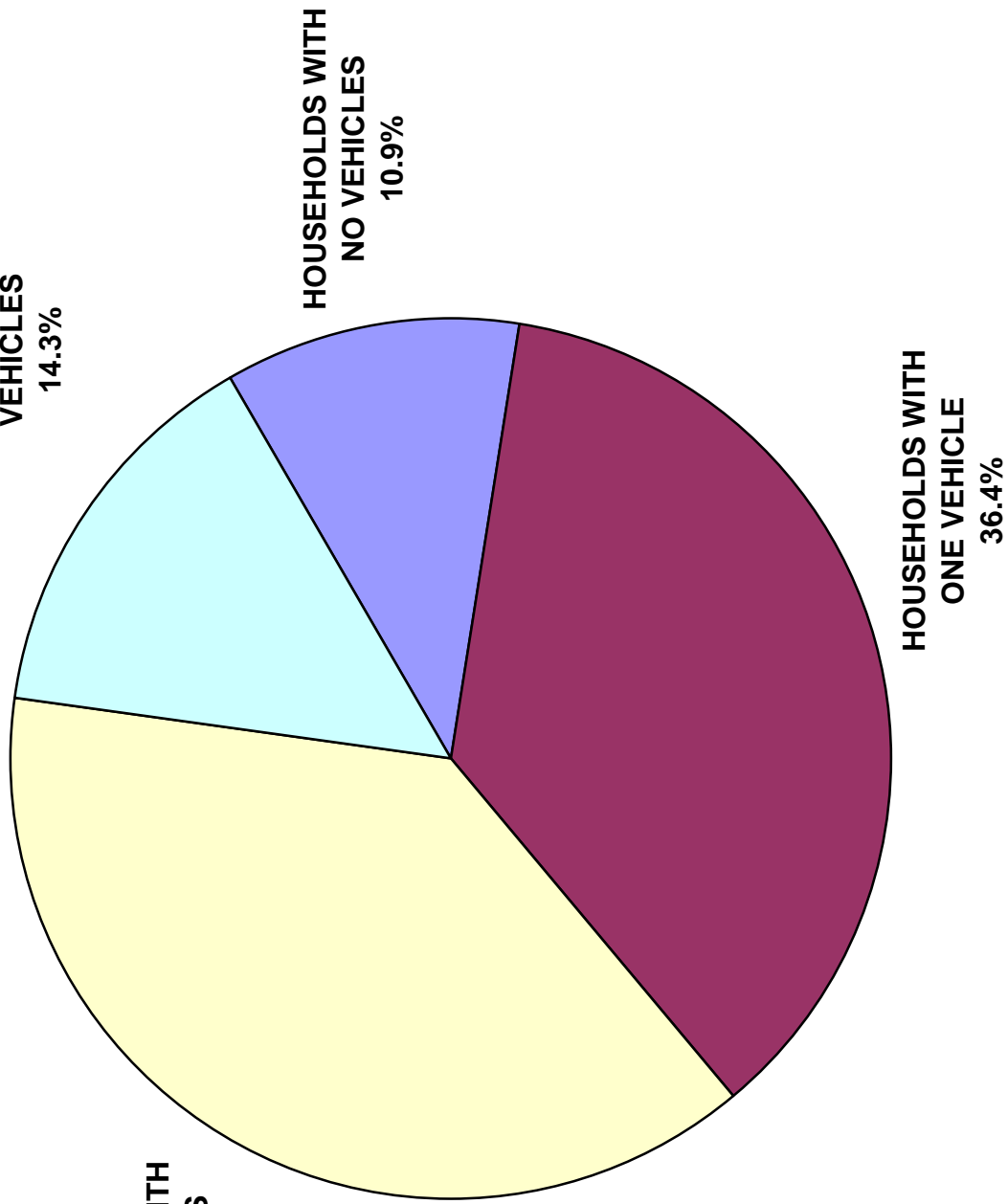

2000**

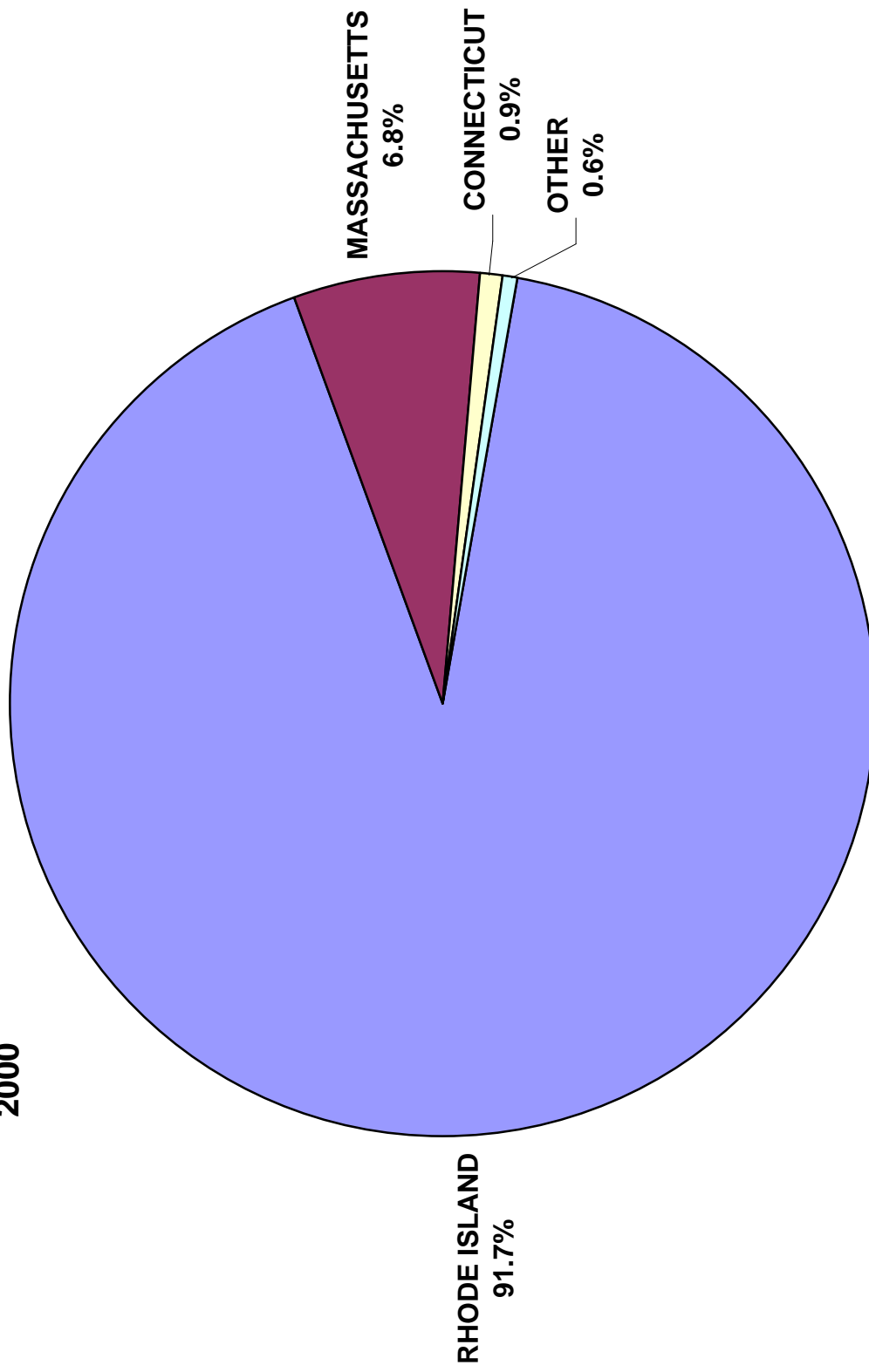

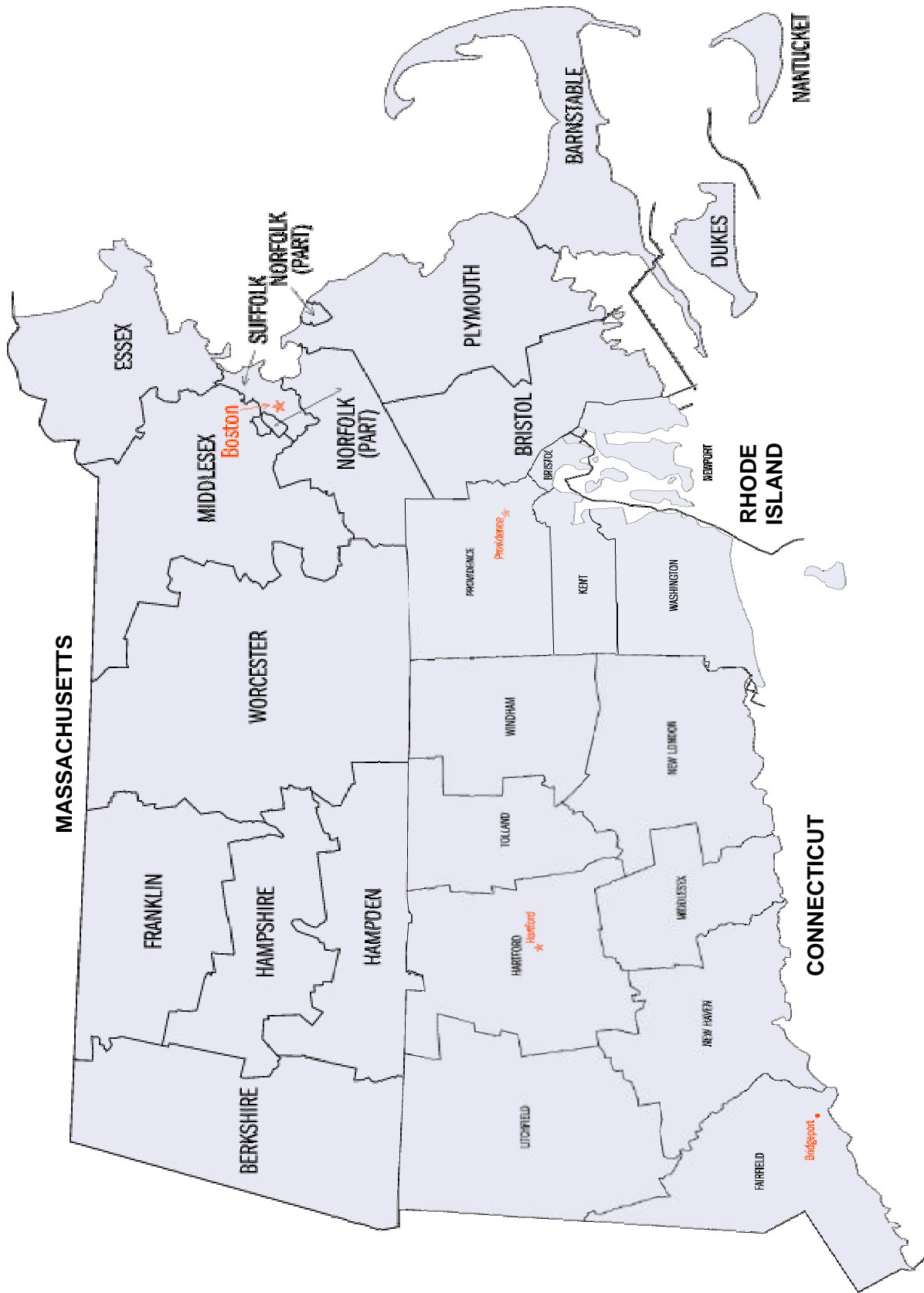
