The Rhode Island Department of Administration, Division of Statewide Planning has received the Rhode Island Department of Transportation's (RIDOT) August 7, 2019 – Request for Administrative Adjustment to the FFY2018-2027 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

Changes are proposed in RIDOT's Bridge Capital Program. Mitigation for Pawtucket Bridge is being shifted out of Immediate Action to its own line item in the STIP. There is no net change in funding in the Bridge Capital Program.

I have reviewed RIDOT's request against the 2003 Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) regarding procedures to amend and modify the STIP. I find that this request constitutes an Administrative Adjustment under the MOU and is hereby approved.

The documentation submitted indicates that fiscal constraint of the STIP will be maintained. For record keeping purposes, please note that this Administrative Adjustment shall be referred to as approved Revision #20 to the FFY2018-2027 STIP. Revised STIP tables incorporating the modifications are enclosed.

SUBJECT: \*REVISED\* Request for Administrative Adjustment to the FFY2018-2027 STIP

The purpose of this memorandum is to summarize the proposed Administrative Adjustment to the FFY2018 – FFY2027 TIP. The net result of this action generates a net-zero change over the constrained period (FFY2018 – FFY2021) and a total net-zero change over 10 years.

The proposed change to the TIP is comprised of one unique action in the Bridge Capital Program. This action, described below, shifts one project out of the Immediate Action – Bridge line item in the Bridge Capital Program into its own line item, with a new description and funding type. The project in questions was originally added to the STIP in Amendment 17. FHWA-RI has requested the change outlined in this amendment request be completed before funding to support the project can be authorized.

Pursuant to the Memorandum of Understanding governing Procedures to Amend and Modify the Transportation Improvement Program, this action constitutes an Administrative Adjustment to the STIP.

### **Bridge Capital Program**

This action shifts a project out of the Immediate Action line item in the Bridge Capital Program into its own line item. The construction of this park will satisfy a stormwater mitigation requirement originally associated with the construction of a detention basin during the reconstruction of Bridge 055001, Pawtucket Bridge at Taft St & Pawtucket River. The mitigation action includes the construction of a park at 20 Division St, just east of the Division St. Bridge.

This project was originally added to the STIP in Amendment 17. Following discussions with FHWA, it was determined that the project was: 1. In need of its own line item with a more robust description; and

2. Could not use earmark funds as originally intended. According to FHWA, these issues needed to be adressed before the project could be advertised.

This amendment satisfies both of the above requirements by:

1. Moving the project from the Immediate Acton - Bridge line item and into its own line item, with an updated description; and

2. Adjusting the funding sources utilized to support the project.

RIDOT has estimated that it will cost approximately \$0.4M to complete construction of the park. This project will be 100 percent funded by Land Sales revenue, which is available to be programmed in the STIP. The source and use tables in the STIP will be adjusted accordingly.
